

Thammasat University Announcement on The Design, Business and Technology Management (International Program), Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Graduate Students Admission, for the 2nd Semester, Academic Year 2024 (2nd Round) (A Translation copy)

Thammasat University invites qualified international candidates to join undergraduate degree course at the Design, Business and Technology Management, DBTM, (International Program), Faculty of Architecture and Planning in the upcoming 2024 academic year. Details of the required qualifications and the admission process can be found below.

1. Place of Study

At the Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University, Rangsit Center

2. Degree offered and number of places available

3. Admission Requirements

Applicant qualifications must be in accordance with the regulations of higher education of the University on Graduate Studies 2018, items 22 - 23 and have the following qualifications:

3.1 The applicant should be a potential graduate from the Design, Business and Technology Management program (International Program), Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University.

3.2 The applicant should be a graduate with a bachelor's degree in fields related to Design, Business Administration, or Technology Management from a domestic or international university approved by the Thammasat University Council and the program's academic committee. The applicants' GPA should be no less than 2.50. Otherwise, minimum 1 year of working experience in a related field is required.

4. Selection Criteria

4.1 The applicant shall take the written and interview exam regarding the Thammasat University Announcement **EXCEPT** those who qualified in requirement **3.1** above with GPA no less than 2.50 is exempt from written examination.

4.2 Those who has the qualification in requirement 3.2 above must declare one of this following English proficiency tests results with the minimum scores below (The scores must not be older than 2 years to the application date):

5. Application process

5.1 Go to the website of Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University, (www.tds.tu.ac.th/dbtm) and click "Admission".

5.2 The applicant should carefully fill in all the required information in sequential order. The information provided through the application form is deemed by the university, which is a part of the applicant's official statements.

5.3 The 1,000 THB application fee have to be payable to Bangkok Bank account number 091-0-28410-8 named **MASTER.DBTM.APTU.**, Thammasat University-Rangsit Center branch. Payment must be completed by December 2, 2024. Any incurred fees charged by the bank must be the applicant's responsibility.

6. Required documents checklist

6.1 A printed copy of the filled in application form with a two-inches photo, taken within 6 months of the application date

6.2 A copy of applicant's national identification card (for Thai citizens) or passport first page (for non-Thais)

6.3 A copy of household registration

6.4 A copy of degree certificate or letter of graduation confirmation or certificate of graduation (Only for applicants who have not graduated from Design, Business and Technology Management Program, Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University)

6.5 A copy of undergraduate transcript

6.6 A copy of name or surname changing certificate (if any)

6.7 English proficiency test results, which could be TU-GET, TOEFL or IELTS, taken within two years of the application date. Applicants who have graduated from Design, Business and Technology Management (International Program), Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University with a GPA of no less than 2.50 are exempted.

6.8 Two confidential recommendations whose details can be found in the attachment. Applicants who have graduated from Design, Business and Technology Management Program, Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University are exempted.

6.9 A portfolio showing achievement in academic and extracurricular works Note: All documents must be signed and certified

Remarks

1. On written and interview examination dates, the applicants must bring along the original national identification card (for Thai citizens) or the passport (for non-Thais)

2. The applicant who fails to declare any of the documents listed will strictly be disallowed from entering the examination room and will be disqualified from the examination.

3. Any kind of cheating will be taken seriously by the university. Cheaters will be disqualified from that examination and barred from further admissions to any programs of Thammasat University.

9. Registration as Thammasat University student

9.1 Once the names of successful candidates are officially announced, they need to confirm their places as Thammasat University students within the suggested dates. Student enrollment process is conducted under Thammasat University Regulations on Graduate Studies A.D. 2018

9.2 Student's names shall be removed from the university if it is found that false or fake documents are used for the application or registration process. Moreover, such students will be criminally charged accordingly. In any case, there is no refund of application fee.
