Title: Fast Track Scholarships for Design, Business and Technology Management  
Program (DBTM) Graduate Students, 2/2024 Academic Year

In order to provide educational opportunities for international students from Cambodia, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Republic of the Union of Myanmar, Socialist Republic of Vietnam (together called CLMV countries), People's Republic of China and other countries to enhance students' diversity and internationality under Thammasat University's policy on international research and education, DBTM International program at the Faculty of Architecture and Planning will offer 4 fast track scholarships in the 2024 academic year. The details are described below.

**1. Scholarship title:** Fast Track Graduate Scholarships for International Students

**2. Scholarship duration:** Three (3) semesters throughout the duration of the MSc study in 2024/2025 academic year

**3. Numbers of scholarship awarded:** 4 scholarships (Only tuition fees are covered.)

**4. Eligibility**

4.1 The applicant must be the national of either one of the CLMV nations, People's Republic of China, or other countries. Thai nationals are ineligible.

4.2 The applicant must already acquire a bachelor's degree from DBTM program or in any other fields related to design, business and technology management from approved higher education institutions with GPAX at least 3.00.

4.3 English proficiency test score is required. One of the following tests obtained within 2 years is accepted.

- TU – GET	500 points and above
- TU – GET (CBT)	61 points and above
- Paper-Based TOEFL	500 points and above
- Internet-Based TOEFL	61 points and above
- IELTS	6.0 points and above

4.4 Good behaviors without disciplinary actions are one of the key considerations.

4.5 The applicant has never received any scholarships from the Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University.

**5. Application conditions**

5.1 The applicant must have already applied and have been offered a place to study an MSc study at DBTM program in 2024/2025 academic year

5.2 The applicant must download an application form available at [www.tds.tu.ac.th](http://www.tds.tu.ac.th), fill in and send it with all required documents as a pdf file to the e-mail address: [dbtm@ap.tu.ac.th](mailto:dbtm@ap.tu.ac.th) titling “Application for DBTM Fast Track Graduate Scholarship 2024” Any incompleteness shall be deemed as disqualified, and shall affect the scholarship application.

#### 6. Application schedule

Scholarship application submission: Now – November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024  
Interview date: To be announced  
Scholarship recipients announcement: To be announced

#### 7. Select criteria

The committee’s consideration and decision is ultimate. The DBTM program reserves rights to change any detail or information without prior notification.

#### 8. Scholarship recipients must be compliant with the following conditions

- 8.1 They have to good academic performance with maintain at least 3.00 accumulated grade point average (GPAX) without “F”, “U”, or “W” in the official transcript throughout the duration of the MSc study.
- 8.2 Credits registered for each term shall not exceed the numbers suggested in the study plans.
- 8.3 They will be requested, at least 24 hours per semester, to participated in activities organised by the DBTM program and/or the Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Thammasat University,
- 8.4 Good behaviors are expected. In case that disciplinary rules are broken and the scholarship recipient is eventually dismissed, the already paid tuition fee must be paid back to the Program within 30 days.
- 8.5 Any withdrawal from any courses, the paid tuition fee must be returned to the Program within 30 days.
- 8.6 Decisions on any other violations apart from the 8.1 – 8.5 clauses shall be ultimately DBTM program’s director consideration.
