Thammasat University invites qualified international candidates to join undergraduate degree course at the Design, Business and Technology Management, DBTM, (International Program), Faculty of Architecture and Planning in the upcoming 2026 academic year. Details of the required qualifications and the admission process can be found below.

**1. Place of study**

At the Faculty of Architecture and Planning building, Thammasat University, Rangsit Center

**2. Degree offered and number of places available**

**3. Candidates eligibility**

**3.1 General requirements**

3.1.1 Applicants must already hold a recognised high school diploma, a grade-12 diploma or equivalent. Otherwise, the applicant must be studying in the last semester of a high school program and must have at least 2.50 GPAX. The GED score higher than 145 for each subject is also acceptable or International test. For applicants from international education systems, equivalent qualification requirements can be found in Appendix A.

3.1.2 Applicants must not be currently enrolled as a student in any other university or higher education institution, except in the case of an open university or an accredited distance learning (online) program leading to a degree.

3.1.3 Applicants must be in good health without diseases that shall obstruct the study.

3.1.4 Decent behaviour is generally expected from all applicants.

**3.2 Specific requirements**

3.2.1 The calculation of GPAX

The score has to be calculated from student's performance in 5 academic terms in the two-term semester system or 7 academic terms in the trimester system.

3.2.2 For applicants with **3.0 and above GPAX**, only one of these validated English proficiency test score is to be submitted with the application form.

**Notes 1:** a) The English proficiency criteria for international programs candidates mentioned above are based on requirements announced by Thammasat University.

b) Any English proficiency tests results shall not be older than 2 years to the document submission date.

3.2.3 For applicants with **GPAX from 2.50 to 2.99**: one of these academic proficiency test scores AND a validated English proficiency test score mentioned in Section 3.2.2 have to be submitted with the application form.

## 7. Selection criteria

7.1 Applicants must pass all requirements stated in Section 3.1 and 3.2 to be eligible for the subsequent interview session which is conducted in English.

7.2 Decisions made by the Program's committee and Thammasat University are considered as final.

## 8. Registration as Thammasat University student

8.1 Once the names of successful candidates are officially announced, they need to confirm their places within the suggested dates. Student enrollment process is subsequently conducted under Thammasat University regulations regarding Bachelor's Degree Studies A.D. 2025.

8.2 Student's names shall be removed from the university if it is found that false or fake documents are used for the application or registration process. Moreover, such students will be criminally charged accordingly. In any case, there is no refund of application fee.

**9. Inclusive fee including tuition and all other charges is 85,000 - 95000 Baht per semester.**

## Appendix A

### Qualifications for Applicants from International Education Systems

This appendix lists international high school qualifications that are considered equivalent to the admission requirements of the DBTM program. Applicants who have completed their education in these systems are eligible to apply, provided that they meet at least the minimum requirements as specified in the tables below.

Indonesia	Math $\geq$ 7.5, English $\geq$ 7.5
Nepal	Math $\geq$ B+ (75%), English $\geq$ B (70%), 2 subjects $\geq$ A/B+
Pakistan	Math $\geq$ 75%, English $\geq$ 70%
Bhutan	Math $\geq$ 75%, English $\geq$ 70%
Sri Lanka (A-Level)	3 subjects $\geq$ B
Cambodia	Math $\geq$ B, English $\geq$ B ( $\approx$ 70–75%)
Maldives (A-Level)	2 subjects $\geq$ B
India (CBSE/ISC)	5 subjects $\geq$ 75%, including Math & English
